ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF

TELLURIDE SUMMER RESEARCH CENTER

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I, the undersigned resident of San Diego, California, being 21 years of age or older, does hereby associate myself and the following named proposed directors together for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation under the statutes of the State of Colorado.

ARTICLE ONE: NAME AND LOCATION:

The name of the nonprofit corporation shall be the TELLURIDE SUMMER RESEARCH CENTER, and its principal place of business shall be at 209 W. Colorado Ave, PO Box 1399, Telluride, Colorado. 4435

ARTICLE TWO: DURATION:

The period of duration of this nonprofit corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE THREE: (a) Purpose: The purpose of the corporation shall be: To dedicate itself by social and educational means to the bringing together of scientists to promote the well-being of mankind throughout the world by the conducting of seminars, research and publication of selected topics in the sciences, particularly, but not limited to, the fields of chemistry, physics, and mathematics; To receive, maintain and administer a fund or funds of real or personal property, or both, to use and apply the whole or any part of the income therefrom or the principal thereof for educational, scientific, literary or charitable purposes; and to do anything else not inconsistent with law, these Articles of Incorporation, or the by-laws of the corporation which may be conducive to those ends.

(b) Powers: Subject to these Articles the corporation shall have and may exercise all of the powers now or hereafter conferred upon non-profit corporations organized under the laws of the State of Colorado.

(c) Restrictions: No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member, director or officer of the corporation, or any other private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the corporation affecting one or more of its purposes), and no member, director or officer of the corporation, or any other private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on the dissolution of the corporation or otherwise. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code

of 1954, as amended. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the board of directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization(s) organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes, as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization(s) under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, as the board of directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the District Court of the county of which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization(s) as said Court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

**ARTICLE FOUR: REGISTERED AGENT AND OFFICE:**

The initial registered agent shall be James M. Craft and the address of the initial registered office shall be 209 W. Colorado Ave, PO Box 1399, Telluride, Colorado 81435.

**ARTICLE FIVE: DIRECTORS:**

The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors of the corporation is ten (10), and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as initial directors are as follows:

**ARTICLE SIX: MEMBERS:** The corporation shall have general members and other classes of members as may from time to time be prescribed by its by-laws. Except as limited by the by-laws, each member shall be entitled to one vote on each matter so submitted to a vote and cumulative voting shall not be allowed. The membership shall have no voting stock

and the initial membership shall be the persons designated as Directors.

**ARTICLE SEVEN: BYLAWS:** The initial by-laws of the corporation shall be as adopted by the Board of Directors, which shall have the power to alter, amend or repeal the same. such by-laws may contain provisions for the regulation or management of the affairs of the corporation which are not inconsistent with law or these Articles of Incorporation.

**ARTICLE EIGHT: AMENDMENT:**  
These articles may be amended in the manner as provided by Colorado law at the time of proposed amendment.

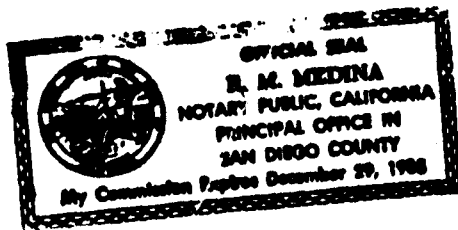
