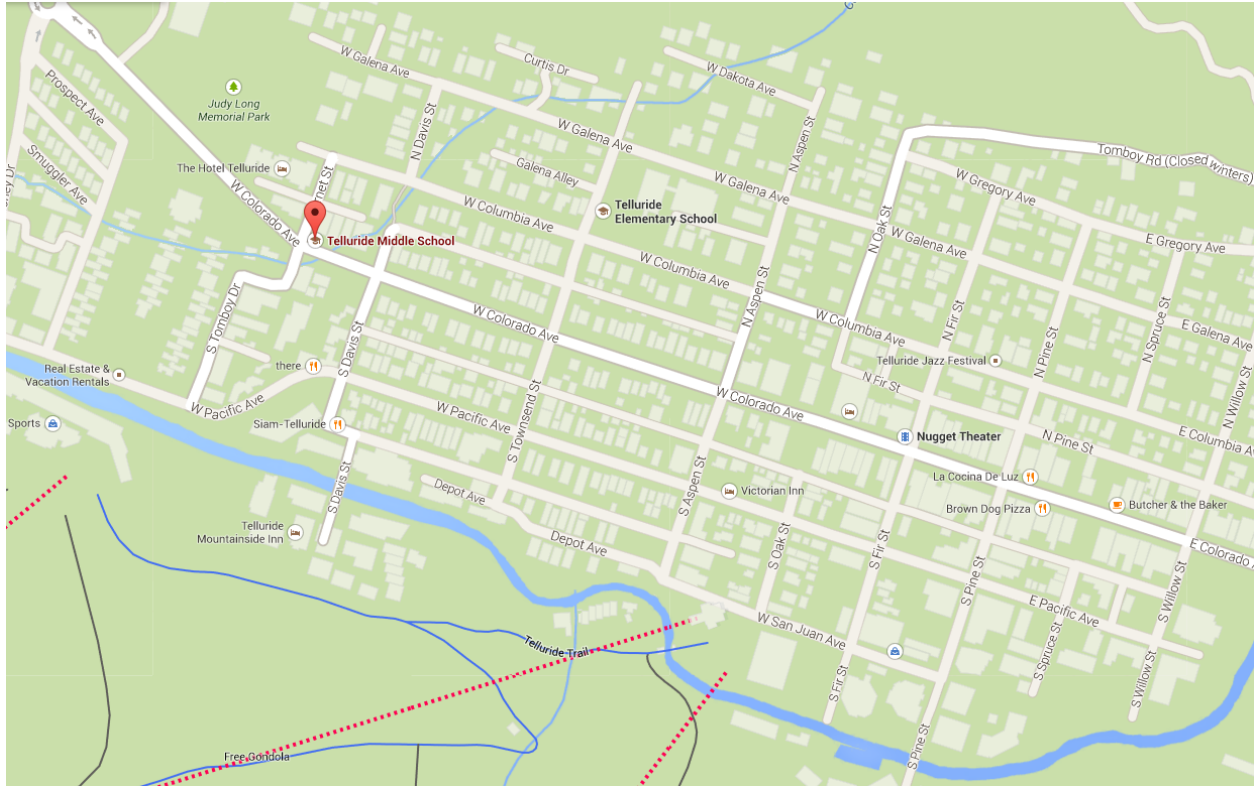


**2014 ISQBP President's Meeting @ Telluride Science Research Center

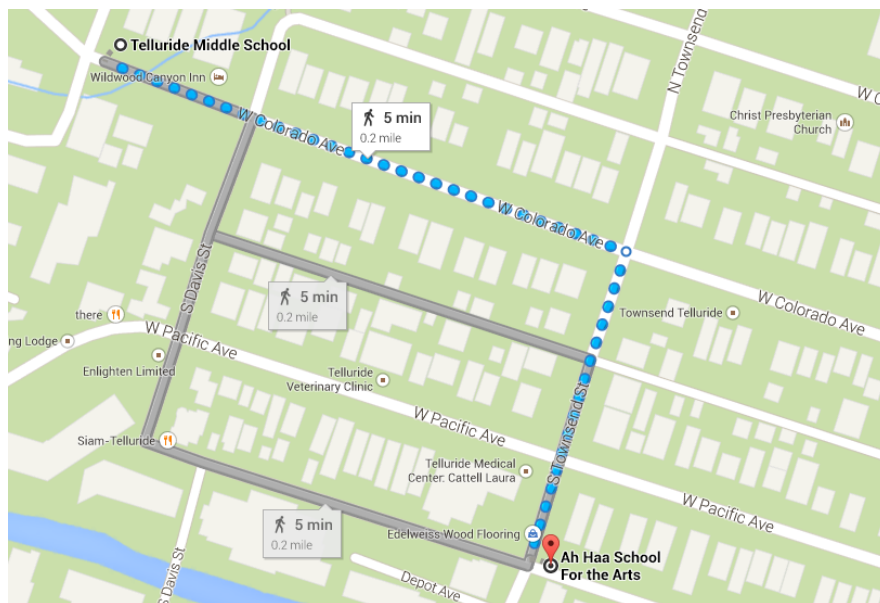
